Envelopes will be available for this purpose or mark your check memo Mexico Fund.



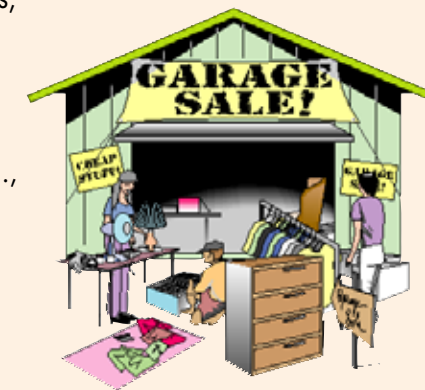
